Residents of Rural City Of Wangaratta can soon take advantage of a free service to safely dispose of old cleaning products, left-over paint, dead batteries and weed killer stored around the home without putting a strain on the environment.

Detox your Home is a free service provided by the Victorian Government to collect potentially dangerous and unwanted household chemical products.

The service is funded by the Victorian landfill levy and administered by Sustainability Victoria in partnership with Rural City Of Wangaratta. It is coming to **Wangaratta on:**

**Date: Saturday 26 May  
Time: 1.00pm and 4.00pm.**

**Location: Council Depot, Newman St, Wangaratta**

**Materials for collection include** left-over paints, brake fluids, fuels and coolants, old batteries, poisonous household and garden products, barbeque gas cylinders, solvents and glues, insecticides and pesticides, photographic chemicals, kitchen and bathroom cleaners and fire extinguishers.

**We will not accept** chemicals used by businesses, farm chemicals, asbestos and empty containers. Containers must be smaller than 20 litres or 20 kilograms.

The collected materials will be treated and recycled, or disposed of safely by a specialist team.
